RANDY VANCOURT

Randy has worked across Canada and the U.S. as a musician, writer and comic. Since summer 2007 he has been touring to sold out audiences and rave reviews with his doo-wop show, **BOARDWALK!** With David Gale he wrote the award-winning comedy **CHUTZPAH à GO-GO**, which ran for 4 years in Canada and had its U.S. premiere in 2009.

TV work includes writing songs for **DUDLEY THE DRAGON**, three **LOVING SPOONFULS** TV specials, and the theme songs for **À LA POURSUITE DE CARMEN SANDIEGO**, **OUR MAGAZINE** and YTV's **DON'T LICK THE PIG**.

He has been a puppeteer with **THE MUPPETS**, a member of the **SECOND CITY**, and is one-half of the Original Canadian **DUELING PIANOS** show, which has been touring extensively since 1999. Randy's song **DONOR CARD** enjoyed wide airplay, and appeared on the syndicated **DR. DEMENTO** radio show.



PAUL GIBSON

A dual Irish-Canadian citizen, Paul is a busy musician and performer and one-third of the hit doo-wop show, **BOARDWALK!** Other credits include: **SALTWATER MOON**, **THE MELVILLE BOYS**, **ROCK AND ROLL**, **PUMPBOYS AND DINETTES**, **YOU'RE A GOOD MAN CHARLIE BROWN**, and **ANNIE GET YOUR GUN**.

For the past 15 years Paul has been half of the popular children's musical duet **THE STYLAMANDERS**.

His 2003 theatrical hit **THAT BOY**, won first prize in the Toronto Fringe Festival playwriting contest. He has written, directed, composed and performed in numerous corporate entertainment events, and recently completed a play chronicling the life of Gypsy jazz guitarist, Django Reinhardt.

Gold Record Winner Thom Speck has opened for Canadian greats **5440**, **MATT DUSK**, **FRED PENNER**, **SPIRIT OF THE WEST**, **ASHLEY MacISAAC** and comedy legend **JAY LENO**. Thom performs with his big bro as the **SPECK BROTHERS** and as a member of the band **THE LAW**, he sings with Canadian Country Artist Marshal Dane.
